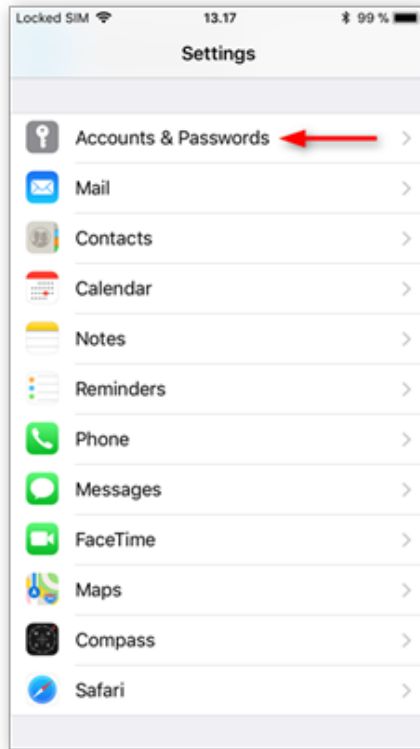


iOS Email Setup

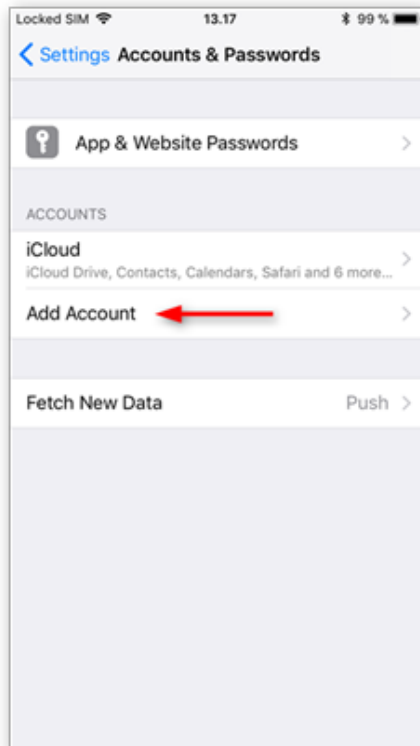
Step 1 - Go to Settings > Accounts & Passwords

Open **Settings** on your iPhone and tap **Accounts & Passwords**.



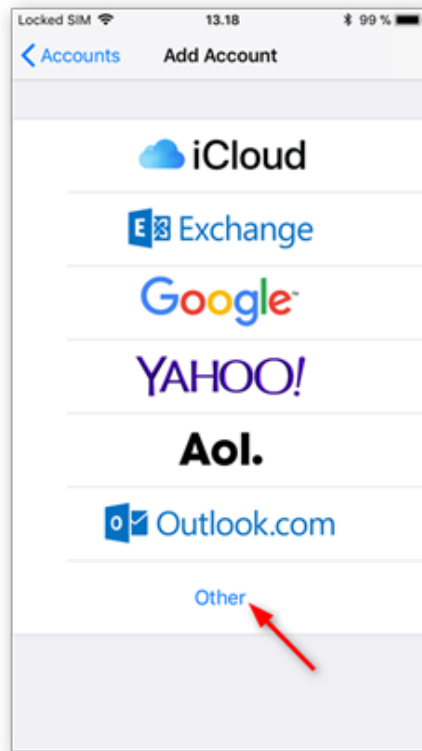
Step 2 - Tap Add account

Tap **Add account**.



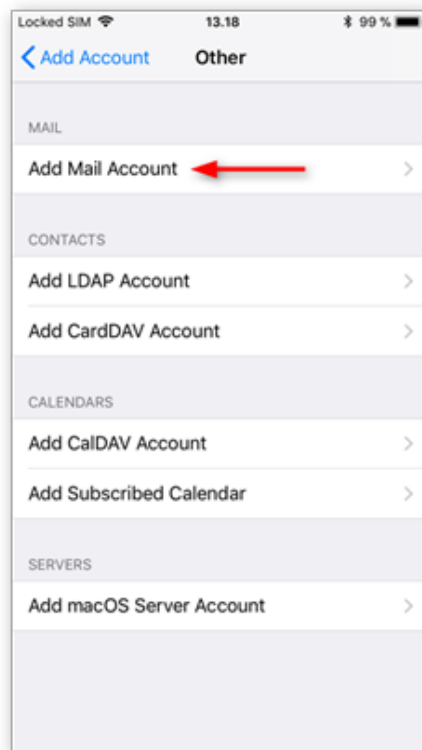
Step 3 - Tap Other

Select **Other** as account type.



Step 4 - Tap Add Mail Account

Tap **Add Mail Account**.




Step 5 - Enter your account details

Enter the account details for the email you want to add:

- **Name:** this will be visible as the sender.
- **Email:** the address you want to add.
- **Password:** you use it to log in to Webmail.
- **Description:** a name for the account on your device.

Tap **Next** to continue.

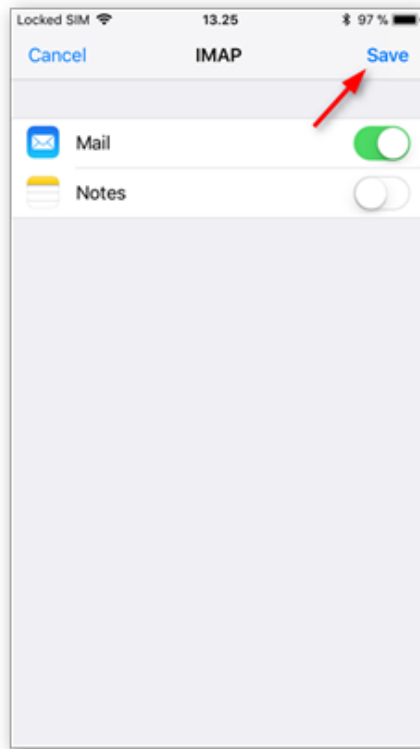

Tap **Next** to continue.

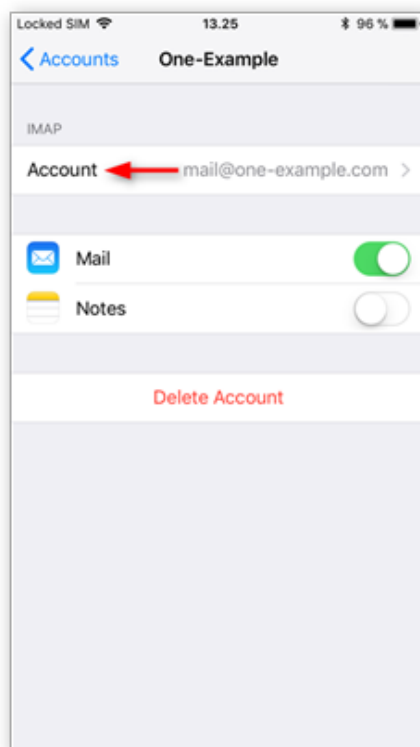
Step 8 - Save the account

Disable syncing of Notes, if this is enabled. Tap **Save**.



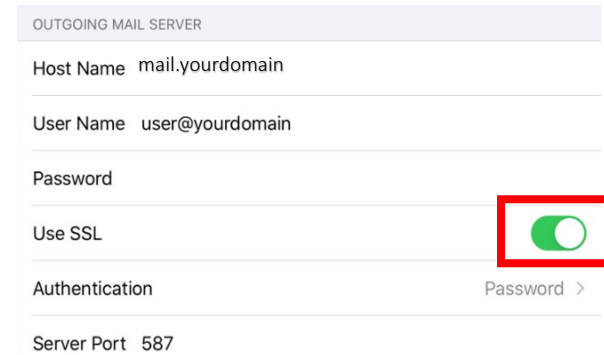
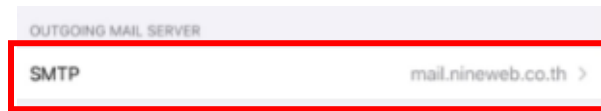
Step 9 - Tap your account again

Tap your account again to open settings.



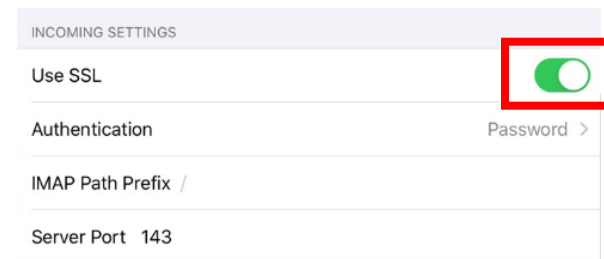
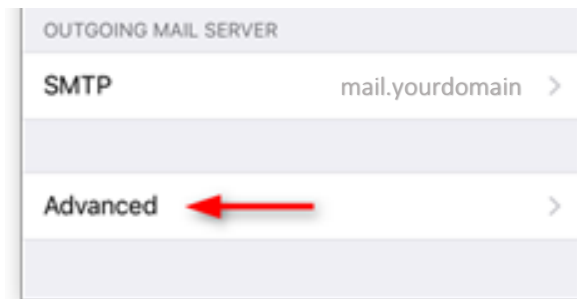
Step 10 – OUTGOING MAIL SERVER – Tap SMTP

PRIMARY SERVER – Tap mail.yourdomain
Use SSL



Step 11 - Tap Advanced – Use SSL

Tap **Advanced**, at the bottom of your screen.



POP port : 110
IMAP port : 143
Use SSL : None

Step 14 - Done!
